DAY ONE: AUCKLAND (D)

Morning Arrive into Auckland. Proceed with immigration and customs formalities and meet your Tour Managers. Collect your luggage and load the coaches. Possible morning breakfast on own (the morning flight will arrive at approx. 6-7am – breakfast is served on the flight). Depart for Auckland Area Sightseeing including the CBD (Central Business District – Queen St.), Mt. Eden, War Memorial Museum, and Auckland Tower.

Afternoon

Lunch on own en route. Late afternoon, transfer to a local area hotel (TBA) and check in. You will have some free time to settle in and freshen up.

Evening

Enjoy a Welcome Dinner as a group in Auckland and return to the hotel.



DAY TWO: AUCKLAND → ROTORUA (B,D)

Morning Breakfast as a group at the hotel. Check out of the hotel and load your luggage. Depart Auckland and head south towards Rotorua (approx. 3 hour coach ride).

Afternoon

Upon arrival, free time to enjoy Rotorua and for lunch on your own. After lunch, enjoy a visit to the Whakawerawera Thermal Reserve to witness the steaming geysers that give Rotorua its distinct smell! Late afternoon, transfer to the hotel (TBA) and check in. Free time to freshen up.

Evening

Transfer to the Tamaki Maori Village. Enjoy a Hangi Feast and Cultural Concert at Tamaki Maori Village. Afterwards, return to the hotel.





DAY THREE: ROTORUA → AUCKLAND (B,D)

Morning Breakfast as a group at the hotel.
Check out of the hotel, load the coaches and depart for the Agrodome. Today you will enjoy the Agrodome Sheep Show, the Agrodome Woollen Mill, and the Agrodome Farm Tour – a hands on tour of the 350 acre farm. You will have opportunities to walk amongst the animals and feed sheep, cattle, deer, alpaca, ostrich and emu by hand. Included in the tour is a stop at the Organic Farming and Horticulture Centre.

Afternoon Lunch on own at the Agrodome.
After lunch, board the coaches and transfer to the Skyline Luge in Rotorua. Upon arrival, enjoy a Gondola ride up Mount Ngongotaha to reach the luge. Enjoy some time on the luge tracks.
Afterwards, return to the base of the mountain, board the coaches and transfer to Auckland.

Late Afternoon Arrive into Auckland and transfer and check into a local area hotel (TBC). Free time to freshen up.

Evening Dinner as a group in Auckland.



DAY FOUR: AUCKLAND → SYDNEY (B)

Morning Breakfast as a group at the hotel.
Check out of the hotel, board the coaches and depart for Auckland International Airport via coach. Arrive at Auckland International Airport, check in luggage, move through Immigration and onto the departure gate. (Please note that all passengers are subject to the New Zealand departure tax. Currently it is priced at NZ\$25.00).
Depart Auckland for Sydney, Australia.

NOTES:

- **Exchange Rate:** Costs are based on an AUD/USD Exchange Rate of AUD 1.00 = USD \$0.8189 and AUD/NZD Exchange rate of AUD 1.00 = NZD 1.15 (as of September 5, 2008). If exchange rate changes by more than 5%, World Projects retains the right to recost the tour.
- **Ground only cost:** Price does not include airfare and related taxes/surcharges.
- **Multi-Share:** Denotes either quad (4 per room) or triple (3 per room) occupancy; however majority of the rooms available will be triple occupancy. Any travelers forced into double occupancy rooms may incur an additional cost.
- **Ground Costs:** Ground costs for 2009 have NOT been released as of proposal date. World Projects has estimated costs for 2009 based on 2008 rates. While World Projects does not expect significant price changes, should ground prices for 2009 be significantly higher actual than estimated, World Projects retains the right to surcharge as necessary.
- **Bledisloe Cup:** Prices are quoted assuming the dates do not clash with the Bledisloe Cup (dates not yet released) which will cause accommodation prices to be higher on weekends.
- **Availability:** This quote is subject to availability of accommodation and vehicles at the time of booking.
- **Numbers:** World Projects reserves the right to recost the extension tour, should the numbers fall below 80 paid travelers or above 99 paid travelers.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE
